**Title of Session** EARLY INTERVENTION ASSESSMENT TRAINING

**Description** Research indicates that helping students who need additional support in the early years improves their chances of being successful in later years. Early Intervention Assessment has been implemented in the CISVA to help schools get to know the students who will be attending kindergarten and identify those who may need additional support during their first year of school.

This workshop will train participants to administer the Early Intervention Assessment as well as score and analyze the data. A second workshop will be offered to assist teachers with appropriate planning to meet the needs of all students and support parents in their role as the primary educators with the goal of an easier transition into kindergarten.
